



Third Social Economy Mission of the R.E.S.E.T. project: promotion of labor inclusion of disabled people

R.E.S.E.T is co-financed by the European Commission and its objective is to create a European network of local and regional authorities devoted to exchanging best practices on social economy as a driver for labor protection and inclusion.

The Third, and last, Social Economy Mission of the project will be held in Bologna on the 22 and 23 of November and will be focused on labor inclusion of disabled people.

The Emilia-Romagna Region and ART-ER (Joint Stock Consortium Company of the Emilia-Romagna), together with the other RESET partners and stakeholders coming from Occitania Region, Valencian Community and City of Zagreb, will confront themselves on policies and practices for the inclusion of disadvantaged and disabled people. During two parallel workshops scheduled for the 22 of November, policy makers, social entrepreneurs, innovators and representatives of local and regional institutions and cooperative centers will discuss the models and networks that can be activated to promote work inclusion in their respective territories.

At the end of the workshops, the delegation will visit the social cooperative La Fraternità and FAAC SPA which has activated, together with Pictor social cooperative conventions art.22 (Regional Law 17/2005) and included people with disabilities among its staff.

On November 23, at the Emilia-Romagna Region headquarter will be held the institutional conference "*Promoting the labor inclusion of disabled people through the social economy: policies, measures and case studies*". Representatives of the Emilia-Romagna, Valencian and Occitan regional institutions will participate and good practices and inclusion projects will be presented by social entrepreneurs from the four project partners.
